Ursuline High School has announced that Larry Kempe has been named the Head Football Coach. Kempe has been the Defensive Coordinator for the Irish since the 2004 season.

Larry Kempe has 38 years of high school coaching experience including stints as Defensive Coordinator at Leetonia, Niles McKinley, Girard and Mathews High Schools. He joined Coach Dan Reardon's staff in 2004 as Defensive Coordinator and was a member of the 2008, 2009 and 2010 Ursuline State Championship Teams. He also served as the Niles McKinley head baseball coach from 1988-1995.

Coach Kempe is a 1971 graduate of John F. Kennedy High School (Warren, Ohio). He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Secondary Education from Youngstown State University and Masters Degree in Curriculum Development from Ashland University. Kempe retired in 2009 from Niles City Schools after teaching for 33 years at both Leetonia and Niles McKinley High Schools.

Kempe has been married for 21 years to the former Traci Simon. They live in Girard, Ohio with their sons: Paul (Ursuline Class of 2011) and Anthony (Ursuline Class of 2013).
